Solve a mystery in a different country: a mystery set primarily in another nation.

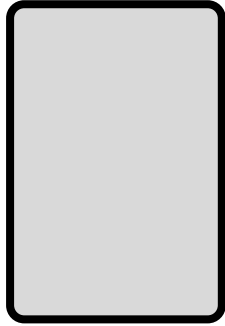
